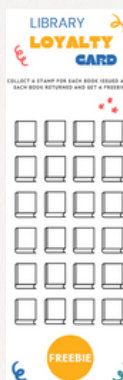


Library Challenge –Golden Ticket Hunt

Reading Challenge –Loyalty Card

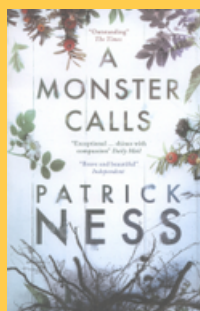
Our readers can take part in this term's reading challenge. Read a book and receive a stamp. Complete the card and earn a prize!
