Rise in St Edward's Students securing Top Grades in 2019 A Levels results

- *Sixth form students from St Edward's School in Poole have achieved outstanding success in this year's A Levels exams.*

A Level results released on Thursday 15th August 2019 reveal that St Edward's Sixth Form has secured a 10% increase in students achieving A*- B grades.

This year's success has been attributed to the hard-working students and the team of highly trained teachers who use holistic approaches to guide their students during their sixth form journey.

Top achieving students at St Edward's Sixth Form include Carly Booker who secured an A* and three A grades and Rufus Morgan who earned an A* and two AA grades. Rufus Morgan will now be going on to study at Imperial College London whilst Carly Booker is set to take a gap year to broaden her horizons.
