Update to remote tutor time

Over the past four weeks I have been really proud of our amazing Key Stage 4 students and their families. Students have made a fantastic start to the year and have really impressed me with their engagement and enthusiasm in their online lessons. There have been so many uplifting moments because of everyone's hard work, it has been a pleasure to hear from staff who are amazed at the resilience and efforts of our students.

At St Edward's students' academic progress is only one of our purposes, with the development of students' spiritual and moral formation being just as crucial especially in these difficult and unprecedented times. With this in mind, I am writing to inform you that we are going to increase the number of live tutor periods from next week to ensure that the pastoral support offered to students at St Edward's continues to be a distinguishing feature of our school.
