Dear Parents and Carers,

Last night the Government announced the return of all students to school from March 8<sup>th</sup>. Whilst we look forward to having everyone back at the earliest opportunity, I must ensure that the return to school is managed cautiously, at a time when COVID levels remain high, though falling; and in a period when vaccine roll-out has as yet only been made available to a targeted proportion of the population.

This initial letter is to ask for your cooperation and understanding in the period ahead; and also to ask you to consider whether you can offer us some of your time as a volunteer to assist with the initial testing of returning students from March 8<sup>th</sup>. We will need volunteers to help us, between the hours of 8.30am – 1.00pm. Any amount of time that you can give will be welcomed and training will be offered by experienced members of staff. Safeguarding measures will be in place at all times. Once we have complied with the Government's requirement, home testing kits will be made available to all of our families. The home testing arrangements will then rely on trust, so that together we can reduce the possibility of an outbreak in our school.

The task of testing will require a *phased return* of students to school from March 8<sup>th</sup>. Further details will follow in due course.
