We will revise all other set texts and skills as normal.

What can you do?

We have created a blank outline revision schedule with key dates and have asked students to fill this in and share with us. You may wish to see a copy of this completed revision schedule and discuss it with your child.

Students have been asked to continue frequent and focused revision through the half term and Easter holidays. This will include a range of activities from re-reading texts, to watching televised performances, to learning key quotations, to annotating unseen texts. We are grateful for your support in allowing them time and space for calm and sensible revision.
