What are the key guidance points from the Advanced Information?

The advanced information identifies the areas of specific knowledge (AO1) that will form the focus of the examination questions that will be set, as well as the required geographical skills.

This gives a core bank of knowledge that the students must know.

What are the main adaptations to the exam?

No adaptations. The examination requirements remain unaltered for this summer series. Students complete Paper 1 Physical Geography and Paper 2 Human Geography topics but papers are 2hr 30 mins in length.

How will we use this information?

Students have been given a copy of the guidance outlining the topics included. We will place a clear emphasis on revising the key topics listed as forming the major part of each exam in lesson time. Students will be expected to revise the other content not specifically mentioned but may support understanding of the core knowledge in questions.

What can you do?

In support of revision you can help test the student with the core knowledge. Doing regular quizzing using the flash cards that they have formed as part of their revision. This will enable students to see if they have mastered the content, as well as giving feedback on how to focus their time better. You can support students in identifying the key content that will be covered in the exam with a discussion of the topics in relation to their revision guide topics.
