Summer Examination Series 2022 – Advice and Guidance for Parents and Carers

What are the key guidance points from the Advance Information?

- Advance information has been supplied for all 3 papers and is broken down by paper but listed in specification order.
 - This allows revision to be more focused in the run up to each exam, for example Arithmetic sequences and series are in Paper 1 but Geometric sequences and series are in Paper 2.
 - Overall the majority of topics are being assessed and even those not mentioned could still be brought in for a low-tariff question. There are very few omissions, so guidance would be to revise everything as normal.
 - Where any 2 topics are on the same line with a semi-colon between them, this is likely to be topics being assessed together in a question or part of a question, but this is unclear.

What are the main adaptations to the exam?

There are no changes to the format of any of the exams, just the release of Advance Information to focus revision appropriately.

How will we use this information?

The information will be used to focus revision at appropriate times and to ensure that revision resources are as well-targeted to the major foci as possible. We have been networking with colleagues across BCP and Dorset to ensure that we don't miss anything that could be useful.

What can you do?

Encourage revision, which should take the form of practice not just reading the book. We will provide a number of additional resources over the coming weeks that they can use to practice.

We have put revision guides and workbooks on WisePay until the 1st of March which will be a valuable revision resource as well.
