What are the key guidance points from the Advanced Information?

- The advanced information has given us specific sections of the course that will be examined within the exams
- The information is clearly spilt into exam 1, 2 and 3
- This information gives us guidance towards the more in-depth questions
- The guidance does mention that other questions could be asked that are not on this released material.

What are the main adaptations to the exam?

- There are not any adaptations- the exams are still the same marks as they have been in previous years
- They all still have a longer marked question
 - o Paper 1 = 20 marker (synoptic)
 - o Paper 2= 10 marker
 - o Paper 3= 10 marker
- They have the same amount of time as previous years.

How will we use this information?

- Students have been given the advanced material
- Students will be given a guidance booklet with content and questions in it. This is base the majority of our revision
- Students will be expected to revise the other content to make sure they don't lose marks on the smaller questions

What can you do?

- Promote revision at home
- See how their booklet is coming along
- Discuss their learning with them
- Help test them and assess their knowledge and understanding

Sources of Revision

- The actual revision booklet
- Previous class notes
- Previous PowerPoints that are on teams
- Revision podcasts
