### What are the key guidance points from the Advance Information?

- Advance information has only been supplied for Paper 1, there is no advance information for Paper 2A or 2B.
- The topics are presented in specification order but the Additional Information column is particularly helpful for focusing revision topics. Where it says *[subtopic] only*, this likely means that anything else in that topic is unlikely to be assessed.
- The preliminary material will still be used and released on the 1<sup>st</sup> of March as usual.

### What are the main adaptations to the exam?

There are no changes to the format of any of the exams, just the release of Advance Information to focus revision appropriately.

### How will we use this information?

The information will be used to focus revision at appropriate times and to ensure that revision resources are as well-targeted to the major foci as possible. We have been networking with colleagues across BCP and Dorset to ensure that we don't miss anything that could be useful.

### What can you do?

Encourage revision, which should take the form of practice not just reading the book. We will provide a number of additional resources over the coming weeks that they can use to practice.
