Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to announce that St Edward's School will be offering a History trip to the Battlefields of World War One, visiting Belgium and France. This visit is from Thursday 11th July to Saturday 13th July 2024. The trip is open to history students currently in year 10 and the cost is £377.

This will be a fantastic opportunity for students to gain a deeper understanding of the impacts of war and enhance their understanding of the GCSE conflict and tension paper. Students will visit a variety of sites connected with the First World War, witnessing first-hand the scale of the conflict as well as visit the battlefields that we study as part of their GCSE. There will be opportunities to get to know staff and students better and build lasting friendships, as well as explore two countries. A sample itinerary is below:

Day One Visit to Belgium, including: -Lijssenthoek -Tyne Cot -Langemark -Memorial Museum Passchendaele, including reconstructed trenches	Day Two Visit to France, including: -Sheffield Memorial Park -Sunken Lane at Auchonvillers -Newfoundland Memorial Park -Lochnagar crater -Theipval memorial	Day 3 Visit to Belgium and France, including: -Hill 62 -Vimy Ridge -Carriere Wellington tunnels, Arras -L'Anneau de la mémoire
Accommodation in Ypres, Belgium	Evening in Ypres, including visits to the chocolate shop and attending the last post ceremony.	Channel crossing and return coach travel to school

Places are limited to 40 students. If you wish your son/daughter to take a place on this visit, please fill out the form on this link: https://forms.office.com/e/pfTFJr6WPS by 9am on Monday 9th October. After this date, if there are more applicants than places, we will conduct a ballot to see who gets a place. We will then send a letter stating whether your child has been successful. If successful, we will require a deposit to be paid by 9am on Friday 13th October. If this deadline is not met, then the place will be re-balloted with students from the reserve list.

I am aware that due to the current climate trips have increased in costing and thus we have set an instalment plan out below to try and give as much time as possible for you to make payments. If you are in receipt of Pupil Premium, there may be financial support for this trip. Please contact myself on akelley@st-edward.poole.sch.uk for more information. Please note that all students travelling will need a valid passport to travel to Europe.

The cost includes all return travel via coach to France and Belgium, two nights of accommodation at The Peace Village, in Ypres, full board meals, all excursions and entrance to the museums and travel insurance. The only additional cost will be any pocket money you wish your child to have for any extras throughout their visit to the battlefields.
