Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to make you aware that the RE department will be offering themed after school revision sessions for Year 11 students, starting after half term. The sessions will take place on a Tuesday and Wednesday each week (the same revision content will be covered on each day each week) and will be delivered by a specialist RE teacher. This revision content will also be uploaded to RE Teams Pages for any students who are unable to attend the sessions after school.

These sessions will be specifically designed to enhance students' basic knowledge and skills that they will need to give them the best possible chance of success in their upcoming GCSE examinations in Religious Studies.

Students will be given more information about these sessions in their lessons. Although individual students, who will benefit from these sessions most, will be encouraged to sign up by their teachers, they are open to all and therefore please do encourage your child to sign up in advance if they are interested in attending.
